PhD Project Proposal Report **Guide for Students and Supervisors**

The Postgraduate School of Life Sciences has introduced a new requirement for all 1st year PhD students to submit a Project Proposal Report for the entire period of study which should outline:

- experimental plans
- timelines
- key questions
- expected challenges

The report should be between 800 – 1000 words in length.

The report will be reviewed by the Psychiatry Postgraduate Education Committee and is assessed for the feasibility of the proposed project, access to appropriate facilities and resources, and confirmation of a good supervisor/student relationship. The assessment provides a useful framework for you and your advisory team to ensure that you are starting off on the right track and have a clear overview of the project.

We hope that this exercise will give you an opportunity to meet with your advisory team, and for us to confirm that all the necessary arrangements are in place and working well. The report should clearly state who is your supervisor, advisor and anyone else providing you with significant academic support.

The submission deadline is Tuesday November 30th 2021. The report should be emailed to the Education Team psych-education@medschl.cam.ac.uk
